

ISOP – Support for Student Mobility

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Possibilities for the students at the Faculty of Eduation

- Exchange studies
 - Faculty of Education agreements subject specific
 - University-wide agreements not subject specific
- Teaching practice abroad (part of VFU course)
- International Summerschools (from our partner universities)
- Erasmus internships (minimum 2 months)
- Thesis writing abroad (incl. Minor Field Study)

Exchange programmes

- Bilateral mainly outside Europe, usually not by subject area (IC, ISOP)
- Erasmus+ in Europe, by subject area (ISOP)
- Nordplus Nordic countries and the Baltic countries, by subject area (ISOP)
- Nordlys Nordic countries and the Baltic countries, not by subject area (IC)



Some figures...

- 60 partner universities in 18 countries
- 50 60 incoming exchange students per year
- 10 15 outgoing exchange students per year
- 3 teaching placement cooperations (+)
- 100 teaching placements abroad per year
- Summer School abroad 1-2 students per year
- Internships and thesis work abroad -?
- Incoming internships and thesis work ?



Decentralized Internationalisation

- Structure of the university International Center / Faculties / Departments
- Most faculties have a faculty coordinator and international coordinators at each department
- Some have an international office that services the whole faculty.
- Some things are coordinated on the central level University wide agreements, Welcome services, Student housing, Summer School for Sustainability

Who does what?

Department

- Exchange agreements and Cooperation agreements with Teaching placement schools
- Provide courses for exchange students
- Study guidance councelling for outgoing exchange students (validation of courses)
- Assessment of eligiblity for incoming students
- Course registration of exchange students
- Internship and thesis work agreements for students

ISOP

- Guidance for students regarding exchange studies and teaching placements
- Updates Mobility database and website
- Applications for exchanges and teaching placement abroad
- Presents course offer and manages course selection incoming students
- Coordinates and signs learning agreements and other documentation
- Coordinates requests from other faculties and International Centre



What does ISOP not do?

- Initiate agreements
- Handle incoming or outgoing internships (apart from teaching placements) or thesis writing
- Validate or assess eligibility for courses
- Support for international programme students (free-movers)
- Summer School for Sustainability
- Student housing or other welcome services
- Handle scholarship applications

And in the future?

- Currently in a re-organisation period
- Opportunity to think strategically
 What do we want with internationalisation?
 How can we organize the work better?
 What support do the students need?
 What support do the departments need?
- The sky is the limit?
- Autumn 2021 limited service
